Adult Care Home Community Advisory Committee

1-Year Initial Term; 3-Year

This committee inspects each Adult Care Home in Person County to assure that the quality of care meets required standards and that the home maintains the Adult Home Residents' Bill of Rights and appointment is contingent upon completing 36 hours of orientation to become state certified.

Agricultural Advisory Board

Advises the Board of County Commissioners on projects, programs, or issues affecting the agricultural economy and agricultural and forestry activities within the county that may affect Agricultural Districts; review and approve/disapprove application of landowners for enrollment of qualified farmland, horticultural land, or forestland into the Voluntary/Enhanced Agricultural Districts; study methods of protection for farming, horticulture, forestry, and the attendant land base, provide recommendations and input on modification to the Farmland Preservation Plan.

Inspects each Nursing Home in Person County to assure that the quality of care meets required standards and that the home maintains the Nursing Home Residents' Bill of Rights; appointment is contingent upon completing 36-hours of orientation to become state certified.

This committee makes monitoring visits the fourth Tuesday of the second month of each quarter at 10:00am and conducts its business meeting on the 4th Thursday of the 2nd month of each quarter at 9:00am.

Opioid Settlement Advisory Committee

Discuss opioid-related health concerns and issues impacting the residents of Person County; advise the Board of Commissioners on options to expend funds to remedy opioid impacts; plan and host an annual meeting open to the public to receive input on proposed uses of the settlement funds and to encourage collaboration between local governments.
